

# Summer Internships in Gulf County!



## Earn While You Learn

The Summer Internship Program, offered by CareerSource Gulf Coast, is an opportunity for young adults to learn valuable real world work skills. Once determined eligible, participants will interview with local businesses and then be selected to work for one of those businesses over the summer months. Others will work at the Summer Leadership Program. Each week, the intern's work habits will be evaluated by their employer. The weekly evaluation will be used to determine the rate of pay, up to \$250 per week.

Interns may be required to submit to a drug and background check (if required by the employer) and must comply with the employer dress code.

## About the Program

**Who:** Young adults aged 16-21 who are economically disadvantaged, and not employed.

**When:** Interns start May 31. Participants must be able to work the schedule offered by their employer site. **Applications will be accepted NOW to May 15.**

**Where:** Internship sites will be set up at different businesses throughout Gulf County, with the program starting May 31. Many interns will be assisting with the summer program at the Washington Gym (Summer Leadership Program runs June 5-July 28).
