



# Disaster Relief Employment Criteria

Career Source Gulf Coast will be providing employment at public and private non-profit entities for eligible people who are currently unemployed. The available positions are as listed below:

- General Laborer—removing debris and restoring facilities
- Humanitarian Worker—sorting donations, providing meals and directing people to services
- General Office Worker—clerical tasks related to disaster recovery

**To qualify for employment, you must be a resident of one of the following counties:**

- Bay, Calhoun, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Leon, Liberty, Taylor, Wakulla or Washington

**You must also meet the at least one of the following criteria:**

- Dislocated worker, meaning you lost your job (not quit) due to no fault of your own.
- Out of work for 6 of the last 13 weeks
- Unemployed and receiving unemployment
- Self-employed, but lost job due to storm
- Received notice of layoff due to permanent closure of business or substantial layoff
